We congratulate you on your decision to continue your education by attending college or serving in the military. Our goal is to invest financial resources to help support your journey.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for consideration for this award, an applicant must:

- Be a Milwaukee County college-bound high school senior, military service, or early graduating junior who will graduate in May or June 2025.
- Show evidence (i.e., acceptance letter(s) for plans for full-time enrollment in a two or four-year college, the military, or a trade school.)
- 3. Be able to attend an exclusive award ceremony on Wednesday, June 11, 2025 at 6:00 pm and sign a media release form.
- 4. Applicants have an opportunity to receive a laptop, scholarship, or both a laptop and scholarship. Your overall score will determine which scholarship you are eligible for. Scores ranging from 2-4 a laptop, 5-7 a scholarship, and 8-10 both a laptop and scholarship.
- 5. Please note* Priority will be given to students in each category who demonstrate financial need through eligibility for free or reduced lunch.

AWARD TIMELINE

The following are the key dates to adhere to:

*Monday, October 11, 2024: Applications available

*Tuesday, January 14, 2025: Application deadline - 4:00 pm (this is a rm deadline; no exceptions].

*Award notification via email and mail will be the week of **April 7, 2025 to April 11, 2025** (Make sure your email/phone number is current!)

*Date and location of Award presentation to be announced.

Please note: All awardees must be in attendance to receive their awards. Failure to attend the designated appointment time will result in forfeiture of the award.

SELECTION COMMITTEE AND PROCESS

Scholarships and Laptop Application Selection Committee will review all applications. The committee is comprised of local professionals including educators, businessmen and women, and individuals who are considered experts in their field. All members share a passion for the post-secondary success of youth in the community. Additionally, each committee member commits to equality and fairness in the review of applications and selecting finalists who best fit the Award criteria. Applicants with the highest scores and percentage in each category will be awarded a laptop, and/or scholarship. Decisions of the Award Committee are FINAL.

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS CHECKLIST Must Submit this form and all boxes must be checked.

Application Form: All areas of the application form must be completed, signed and dated by applicant and their parent[s] or guardian[s], unless 18 years of age at the time of submittal.
Essay: Please select one of the following major issues to answer in a minimum of: 400 words Applicant's essay must state essay question as the title/ heading and be neatly typed in Arial or Times New Roman, 12 - point font, double-spaced, with applicant's name, contact information, high school, and word count in the top right corner of each page.
Official Transcript: All transcripts must include information on applicant's most recent available grade period. Please see individual categories for minimum grade point average requirements. Only transcripts that are stamped or embossed with the high school's official seal will be accepted.
Recommendation Letters: Two [2] signed letters of recommendation from a teacher or school staff person[s] or from community representatives [i.e., clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.] who can attest to applicant's qualifications. Letters written by family members or friends are not acceptable. Please ensure that all letters of recommendation are addressed to Greater Milwaukee

Urban League.

EVALUATION CRITERIA BY SCORE

Scholarships and laptops will be evaluated by scores, timeliness, and completed application with proper documents. **Not having proper documents will automatically disqualify your application. All documents need to be uploaded using a PDF file.**

A complete application includes:

A complete application with all lines filled in.

Official high school transcripts.

Two letters of recommendation specific to this scholarship.

College acceptance letter.

A completed essay with proper formatting.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applicants for the Greater Milwaukee Urban League's High School Graduate Scholarship(s) and Laptop Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. Submission of the full application with the checklist. 10%
- Recommendation Letters: Two [2) signed letters of recommendation from a teacher or school staff person(s) or from community representatives specifically for the GMUL Scholarship. - 20%
- 3. Official Transcript (if available) in a Sealed Envelope (if mailed): All transcripts must include information on applicant's most recent available grade period and reflect a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale. 20%
- 4. Essay question: Clarity, grammar, punctuation, organization, depth of content and compassion displayed in the essay question -will account for the bulk of the scoring. 50%

- 4. How will the Greater Milwaukee Urban League Laptop and/or Scholarship Award make a difference for the success of your college or military service, and how important is this award overall in eliminating financial burden to you or your family? Answers must be a minimum of 400 words, and be specific in your "why" and "how." (i.e., "Why" this is important to you, and "How" you would address it.)
