1. WHAT IS THE YOUTH LEADERSHIP SUMMIT 2018?

The Youth Leadership Summit 2018 is a FREE one-day leadership training opportunity for Milwaukee-area youth in the **9th through 12th grades**. The event will be held on **Saturday, May 5th, 2018, from 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.** at the Harley-Davidson University Building, 6th Floor, 3800 W. Juneau Avenue, Milwaukee, WI. All participants will get a **FREE lunch and be entered in a drawing for a TABLET computer and other prizes**. Although the name, Youth Leadership Summit, suggests an emphasis on leadership, the event will consist of three overlapping and complementary components:

- *Leadership Development* – practice and development of leadership skills.
- *Citizenship/Community Involvement* – volunteering in the community, participating in and developing an understanding of the importance of civic engagement.
- *Personal Development* – assessing your strengths and weaknesses, goal setting, and financial literacy.

The Youth Leadership Summit 2018 is a collaborative effort between Pathways Milwaukee, the Milwaukee Urban League and the Milwaukee Urban League Guild and Young Professionals.

2. WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR SELECTING YOUTH TO PARTICIPATE?

School officials and leaders of community groups must identify **eligible students and have them complete the application form at the front of this sheet. The form MUST also be signed by their parent(s)/guardian(s):**

We are seeking participation from youth who:

- a) Have a record of good behavior and personal conduct, and a C average or above.
- b) Demonstrate leadership ability through involvement in school, extracurricular, or community activities.

3. WHEN IS THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING THIS APPLICATION FORM?

The deadline for submitting the application form is **Friday, April 13, 2018**.

4. WHEN WILL APPLICANTS BE NOTIFIED?

Applicants and the individuals who nominated students will be notified by Wednesday, April 25, 2018.
